Articles of Organization

ARTICLE I:

Name;

1. The name of this organization will be Saint Andrew Society Vermont, hereinafter referred to as the Society, a/k/a SASVT.

ARTICLE II:

Purpose;

1. The purpose of the Society is to sponsor and promote traditional Scottish activities.
2. To educate anyone interested in Scottish culture, traditions and history.

ARTICLE III:

Officers;

1. Elected officers of the Society shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Treasurer and a Secretary.
2. These officers will be referred to as the Executive Board.
3. Appointed officers may be designated with approval of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE IV:

Meetings;

1. There will be an annual meeting of the Society in either April or May.
2. There may be other regular meetings set by the Executive Board annually.
3. There can be special meetings called by any Board member and warned 30 days in advance.
4. Meetings can be held in person and / or virtually.

ARTICLE V:

Governing;

1. The Board will draft the By-laws as the governing document of the Society and may appoint additional help from the membership to draft said document.
2. The Executive Board may make amendments to the By-laws annually or at other times if needed.
3. All By-law amendments must be warned 30 days prior to a meeting to vote on the changes.

Policies and Procedures;

1. The Board shall set up Policies and Procedures for the Society.
2. These may be amended at anytime by the Executive Board.
