Articles of Organization

ARTICLE I:

Name:

1. The name of this organization will be Saint Andrew Society Vermont, hereinafter referred to as the Society, a/k/a SASVT.

ARTICLE II:

Purpose;

- 1. The purpose of the Society is to sponsor and promote traditional Scottish activities.
- 2. To educate anyone interested in Scottish culture, traditions and history.

ARTICLE III:

Officers:

- 1. Elected officers of the Society shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Treasurer and a Secretary.
- 2. These officers will be referred to as the Executive Board.
- 3. Appointed officers may be designated with approval of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE IV:

Meetings;

- 1. There will be an annual meeting of the Society in either April or May.
- 2. There may be other regular meetings set by the Executive Board annually.
- 3. There can be special meetings called by any Board member and warned 30 days in advance.
- 4. Meetings can be held in person and / or virtually.

ARTICLE V:

Governing;

- 1. The Board will draft the By-laws as the governing document of the Society and may appoint additional help from the membership to draft said document.
- 2. The Executive Board may make amendments to the By-laws annually or at other times if needed.
- 3. All By-law amendments must be warned 30 days prior to a meeting to vote on the changes.

Policies and Procedures;

- 1. The Board shall set up Policies and Procedures for the Society.
- 2. These may be amended at anytime by the Executive Board.
